



Sustainable Investment Policy

The National University of Singapore (“NUS”) is a leading global university. NUS is committed to environmental sustainability and social responsibility, and invests its endowment portfolio responsibly and ethically. NUS believes that in the long term, this commitment towards investing responsibly is aligned with its objective to generate a consistent stream of income to support the activities of the University.

The Investment Office (“IVO”) manages the investment portfolio of NUS. IVO takes a long-term perspective in its investing, and incorporates environmental sustainability, social responsibility and corporate governance factors in its investment decision-making.

IVO invests primarily through external investment managers and believes that active engagement with its external managers can have a positive impact. IVO will only invest with external managers who are committed to investing responsibly.

IVO is cognisant of the impact of environmental changes, and the need for the world to transition to a greener and more sustainable environment. IVO supports this transition, whilst recognising that during this transition, the world will still be dependent on non-renewable energy sources. As such, IVO will be pragmatic in supporting this transition through reallocation of its investments over time, and through continual engagement with its external investment managers and stakeholders.
